For 900 days Ezra Levant fought the Human Rights Commission because he published a story about the Danish cartoons of Mohammad. He became the only person in the world to face legal sanction for printing those cartoons. He was eventually acquitted. As a result of this nightmare, Ezra Levant began investigating other instances in which innocent people have had their freedoms compromised by bureaucrats presuming to protect Canadians' human rights.
