Become a Candidate for the OLP

The Ontario Provincial Election is less than 3 months away and we are looking for candidates to run in ridings across the province. This is going to be a crowded election with a few new Ontario parties in the mix, but only the Ontario Libertarian Party is running on the same principles that were established in 1975 when the party was created.

According to the Election Act, every person is qualified to be a candidate who, at the time of signing the consent to nomination,

(a) is of voting age;

(b) is a Canadian citizen;

(c) has resided in Ontario for the six months preceding polling day; and

(d) is not disqualified by the Legislative Assembly Act or by any other Act. R.S.O. 1990, c. E.6, s. 26 (1).

No person who has been engaged as a returning officer, election clerk, revising agent or revision assistant at the revision of any list of electors to be used at the election, is eligible as a candidate. R.S.O. 1990, c. E.6, s. 26 (2); 2010, c. 7, s. 18.

The Election Act can be found at the following link: <u>https://www.ontario.ca/laws/statute/90e06#BK86</u>. The rules for whom may be a candidate can be found in subsection 26(1) and 26(2).

We will help you prepare your paperwork and get ready for debates if you would like to be an active candidate. Make sure you check with your workplace first in case you need to take a leave of absence to run as a candidate.

Why the Last 2 Years Happened – The State of Freedom Denied
